

Girls With Wings, Inc. Scholarship Application 2011

Description: The Girls With Wings, Inc. (GWW), scholarship is awarded to help defray the cost of flight training lessons in pursuit of a private pilot certificate.

Deadline for submission of application: Midnight EST July 31st (Window opens July 1st).

Eligibility requirements:

Applicants must be a US Resident and at least 16 years of age at the time of application and qualified to continue training toward a private pilot certificate.

Applicant must have accomplished their solo and hold a current medical certificate.

By submitting an application, applicant agrees to the terms outlined in this document.

Required attachments:

Cover letter to include personal contact information.

Essay (see scoring criteria below).

Photo labeled as “[Name] 2011 Scholarship.”

This document with signature. Applicants under the age of 18 must also have parent’s or guardian’s signature.

Copy of logbook pages showing successful solo flight completion; include total flight time and explain any breaks in training and describe recent flight experience if necessary.

Copies of student pilot and medical certificate.

Scoring criteria: The following areas will be graded on a scale from 1 to 5 by the GWW Scholarship committee.

Essay must clearly delineate the applicant’s plan for pursuing a private pilot’s certificate as well as reasons and vision for becoming a role model for the Girls With Wings® organization.

Essay is to describe motivation and inspiration for involvement in aviation.

List of achievements and participation in other organizations and related events.

Financial need should be covered in the essay.

Awardee’s responsibilities:

Awardee must immediately inform GWW of the flight school at which she is training so that a letter from Girls With Wings, Inc., can be sent to notify the flight school that \$1000 in funds is being held in awardee’s name subject to successful completion of the following requirements.

The scholarship winner must submit at least one picture and an associated journal entry on Sep 30th and on Oct 31st to the Girls With Wings message board to share with others her training, as well as email a final essay with picture(s) by Nov 30th of the same year, summarizing how the scholarship helped her, what she learned and her intent to continue her work as a role model for the Girls With Wings, Inc., organization.

The winner must also submit proof of the flight training accomplished with receipts from the same certified flight school to receive the check for up to \$1000. Check will be mailed Dec 1st if all requirements have been met. Scholarship winner must meet these deadlines without prompting as GWW maintains no responsibility to remind scholarship winner of these requirements.

Awards may not be used to pay for flying club dues/membership, ground school fees, books, other pilot supplies, etc. Funds not used by Dec 1st in the year of the award of funds for flight training purposes indicated in this application will be returned to the Girls With Wings, Inc., Scholarship Fund.

Information Release -- I hereby grant to Girls With Wings, Inc., and to their respective employees, agents and assigns (collectively, "GWW") the right to use the documents and images ("Images") that I have submitted to the organization for the purpose of promoting GWW's business activities, whether by electronic, print, or digital media or by electronic publishing via the Website or any other website owned and operated by GWW. If I am declared the recipient of this scholarship, I agree to the terms of this award. I also understand that this application will be disqualified if incomplete or if submitted after the deadline.
